**Subject:** update on watershed planning status

Hi all –

I thought some of you might appreciate an update on the watershed planning, since my last communication with you was on September 19<sup>th</sup>. I mentioned that the plan is now available for public review. It is on the watershed website: [www.auxsablecreekwatershed.org](http://www.auxsablecreekwatershed.org) as well as in a couple local libraries: Yorkville, Oswego, Minooka & Channahon.

My 9/19 e-mail anticipated a November public information meeting on the draft plan. However, I do not think this is the plan anymore. IEPA has been working to arrange this & had to cancel their tentative date. I have not heard of a new date. I will let you know when I have more information. Based on this change, I'd anticipate a follow up advisory committee meeting might not be until January, maybe even February.
